Climate Change

The Earth climate is changing at an accelerating pace due to human greenhouse gas emissions. The effects of the changing climate are becoming increasingly obvious.

Kent Rowe and Holger Meyer will present some current statistics and context and then lead a discussion



on what irreversible damage has been done, how to best counter further damaging effects of climate change and reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and how the climate change issue relates to other social justice issues.

Kent is retired from teaching for the US Air Force and has worked in environmental monitoring and restoration. His Chickasaw heritage and time spent in New Zealand influence his perspective. Holger is a professor of physics at Wichita State University. He grew up in Germany and brings a European perspective. Both have decades of experience in environmental and climate activism. They also led the installation of the solar photovoltaic array at First UU church.
