Endangered Environments

Bob Waltner was born in central India and attended a boarding school at an elevation of 6,500 feet situated in hill station in the Himalayas. His family returned to the United States after he completed Middle School. Bob attended Bethel College for four years and graduated in the Spring of 1964 with a Biology major. He did his graduate work at the University of Kansas. His PhD thesis dealt with the altitudinal ecology of a rock lizard occurring in the western Himalayas. Almost all of his teaching has been at the high school level, Honors and Advanced Biology. Bob taught 3 years at his old boarding school, 13 years at Wichita Collegiate School and 21 years at Taipei American School in Taiwan.

Besides teaching, Bob took students as well as interested adults on caving and field trips in Kansas and Missouri, took students and adults on trips to India hiking in the Himalayas to get a comparison to the birds and other wildlife and plants of Kansas. Bob also visited national parks in Australia, Thailand, Malaysia, Indonesia, and Vietnam and more recently photographed birds in Belize and Ecuador.
